Bloodstock/Livestock Insurance

CATTLE

Our livestock facility, underwritten at Lloyd's, allows us to arrange tailored insurance solutions for the cattle industry. Our livestock specialists are able to provide our clients with worldwide coverage against:

ALL RISKS OF MORTALITY – death or destruction on humane grounds, by accident, sickness or disease.

NAMED PERILS – death or destruction on humane grounds as a result of specific harmful events or hazards (agreed named perils) such as fire, hail, or mechanical breakdown.

BULL BREEDING WARRANTY – congenital infertility.

BLUE TONGUE – death or destruction on humane grounds as a direct result of blue tongue. (Coverage is excluded in the Okanagan Valley)

The following additional coverages are available although coverages can be designed to meet the needs of individual clients:

LIMITED THEFT AND UNLAWFUL REMOVAL – death or loss of animal resulting from theft or unlawful removal.

BULL INFERTILITY – loss of use (economic slaughter) following permanent infertility, impotency or being incapable of breeding as a result of accident, sickness or disease.

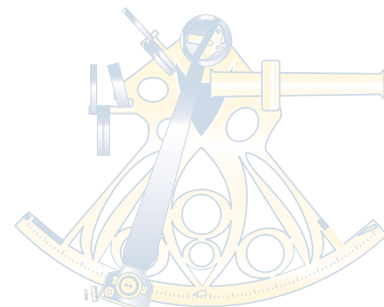
SALES AND SHOW COVER – covers available include 'fall of hammer' and short period insurance including farm to farm and farm to sale (or show) until fall of hammer and/or return to farm.

TRANSIT INSURANCE – domestic or international transit, by air, sea, or road, which can be extended to including pre and post transit quarantine and retests.

ANIMAL DISEASE – Government slaughter

Foot and Mouth pays 25% of government compensation or sum insured, whichever is the lesser, following contraction of foot and mouth and slaughter of livestock by order of the government.

Limits and cover can be amended to meet the requirements of individuals.

SHEEP

ALL RISKS OF MORTALITY – death or destruction on humane grounds, by accident, sickness or disease and theft.

RAM INFERTILITY – loss of use (economic slaughter) following permanent infertility, impotency or being incapable of breeding as a result of accident, sickness or disease.

PIGS & POULTRY

Our livestock specialists are able to provide individual and tailored insurance solutions for the pig and poultry industry including coverage against:

NAMED PERILS – death or destruction on humane grounds as a result of specific harmful events or hazards (agreed named perils) such as fire, hail, or mechanical breakdown.

ALL RISKS OF MORTALITY – death or destruction on humane grounds, by accident, sickness or disease and theft.

The following additional covers are available:

LIMITED THEFT AND UNLAWFUL REMOVAL – death or loss of animal resulting from theft or unlawful removal.

SUFFOCATION – following mechanical breakdown and power failure subject to suitable backup and life support equipment.

TRANSIT INSURANCE – all risks of mortality coverage can be extended to include international transit, by air, sea, road or rail to and from other approved countries. Including pre and post transit quarantine.

ANIMAL DISEASE – Government slaughter

***FOOT AND MOUTH** pays 25% of government compensation or sum insured, whichever is the lesser, following contraction of foot and mouth and slaughter of livestock by order of the government.

***AUJESZKY'S DISEASE** pays 25% of the market value or 25% sum insured, whichever is the lesser, following contraction of aujeszky's disease and slaughter of pigs by order of the government.

***CLASSICAL SWINE FEVER** pays 25% of government compensation or sum insured, whichever is the lesser, following contraction of classical swine fever and slaughter of pigs by order of the government.

***SWINE VESICULAR DISEASE** pays 25% of government compensation or sum insured, whichever is the lesser, following contraction of swine vesicular disease and slaughter of pigs by order of the government.

AVIAN INFLUENZA – business interruption (loss of income) to the insured's business due to poultry at an insured farm contracting highly pathogenic avian influenza subtypes H5 or H7 which results in the government issuing an order requiring the slaughter of birds on the farm.

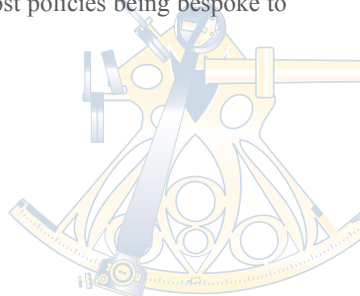
EXOTICS AND OTHER LIVESTOCK
